The Little Mermaid

It was completed in 1913 to honour the author of The Little Mermaid, Hans Christian Andersen. He also wrote The Emperor's New Clothes and the Ugly Duckling.

Lego House

The LEGO Group was founded in Billund in 1932 by a man named Ole Kirk Kristiansen.
